Community Formation Workshop Planned!



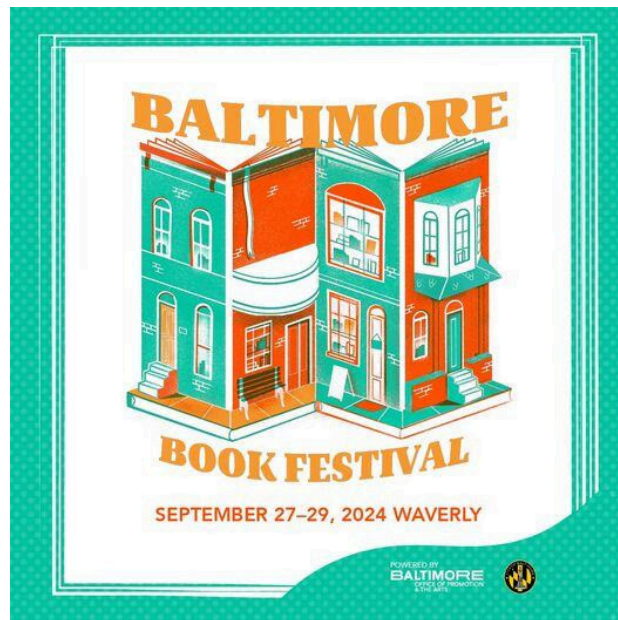
Save the Date: Kickoff Workshop on Nov 9 and 10

We have tentatively scheduled a Kick-off workshop on November 9 and 10! This two-day workshop is a community formation event for anyone who is interested in joining Cohousing of Greater Baltimore. It is the first interactive step in the development of our community. Katie McCamant, author, development consultant and President of Cohousing Solutions, will facilitate the

workshop in person in Baltimore. Topics include the current status of the site and our vision, development roles & responsibilities, development process, estimated prices, collaborative design process, development budget, political process and next steps. We will have several community-building exercises, too. We expect our architect to join for part of the workshop. The cost will be \$195 for one person, and \$35 for the second person from a household.

Cohousing of Greater Baltimore Participates in Virtual Tour Hosted by Mid-Atlantic Cohousing No Bus Tour - "Cohousing in the Works"

On September 7th, CGB was one of three cohousing groups offering virtual tours of their "in the works" communities. "In the works" refers to communities just beginning development, or in one case, an existing community opening phase 2, offering 10 new homesites.

CGB gave a presentation about our vision and plans, as did Liberty Village in Libertytown, MD and Altair EcoVillage in Kimberton, PA. The program was recorded and will soon be made available to view on the website of [Mid-Atlantic Cohousing](#) (MAC), an educational non-profit formed to support the development of cohousing communities in the Mid-Atlantic region.

The program was well attended and great questions were fielded by presenters and members of the MAC Board.
